The Village is now proposed to be constructed subject to the registration as a retirement village scheme by the Queensland Government under the Retirement Village Act. The Expression of interest is not a binding contract and no money is paid. Greengate is also the approved aged care provider for the village and have been allocated bed licences by the Commonwealth Government.
